Fishery:	Commercial - Treaty Troll
Target Species:	Salmon – All Species
Season:	Opens: September 16, 2026 at 12:01 AM Closes: September 30, 2026 at 11:59 PM
Allocation:	Not to exceed the 800 Coho quota per week
Management Area:	Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to Queets River 47° 31' 42" N
Legal Gear:	Single point, single shank, barbless hook No more than 8 fixed lines per boat
Size Limit:	Chinook: 24 inches or 18 inches with head off Coho: 16 inches or 12 inches with head off Pink: No size limit
Notes:	Chum Salmon Retention is <u>prohibited</u> from 8/1–8/31 The area within a <u>six</u> -nautical mile radius of the mouth of the Hoh River will be closed to commercial fishing C&S Salmon Regulation. # 26-04-17-B All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinance 2019-A-40
